Log Line: A team of Big Apple fashionistas export two suitcases worth of vintage clothing to Russian teenagers in a cursed black market scheme.

Director's Bio: Raised on a steady diet of fashion magazines and music videos, Minneapolis filmmakers and life-long best friends JoEllen Martinson and William Scott Rees have funneled their style-minded, angst-fueled lives into a string of acclaimed, female-focused films under their CandyEyeFactory.com video label, founded in 2003.

Production Notes: While wading through piles of vintage clothing to assemble costumes for their 2002 dark comedy, *Brite*, co-directors Martinson and Rees uncovered a 1980s-era blouse under the brand name *Daddy's Money*. Struck by the greedy sass and retro logo of the label, inspiration for *The Mallorys Go Black Market* movie hit the giddy filmmakers full-force.
